

2017 Biker's Showcase Entry Rules and Procedures

- All Biker's Showcase entries must be preregistered, entry forms are available at <http://indianamotorcycleexpo.com/wp-content/uploads/2016/12/BikerShowcase2page2017.pdf>
- This is a by invitation only event only. Categories may be added or withdrawn without notice.
- **Biker's Showcase is for bikes that are owned and entered into the Showcase by private owners and not owned by a shop or commercial business. Displaying of commercial information, for sale signs, business cards etc are not allowed. You may not set up chairs or "hang out" within the designated Bikers Showcase area.**
- Registered bikes receive an entry number. This number is placed by the bike and is used for judging and for voting in People's Choice.
- Registration information includes name, address, city, state, zip, email, phone and year of bike, model of bike, license number, and category. We need some of this info to contact the award winners.
- Although preference is given to bikes that can be ridden in, non-running bikes may be acceptable and this is at the discretion of event management.
- Bikes must be in place by noon Friday, February 17th. Judging is from 1-4 pm on Friday, February 17th. People's Choice votes will be collected all weekend until 2pm on Sunday, February 19th
- Judges review the bikes in each category to determine 1st place.
- Any show visitor may vote for People's Choice.
- Awards for each category are awarded at 4:45 pm on Friday, February 17th
- Trophy for Best of Show is awarded at 5:00 pm on Friday, February 17th
- Photo session is immediately after award presentation. Winners, please stay with your bike for photos. The Expo does not provide a photographer however you are welcome to take your own pictures. The Expo provides the models for the photo opportunity.
- No fuel leaks allowed.
- By order of the Fire Marshall, fuel must be shut off, tank drained and battery disconnected while parked inside the building.
- Categories may change from one year to the next in an effort to present a diverse array of bikes. Suggestions for new categories are always welcome. (We do not offer brand-specific categories.)

Judging Criteria

Judging will be on the following categories:

- (A) Accessories
- (B) Originality
- (C) Craftsmanship
- (D) Overall Appearance
